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Amendment # 1 - Submission Deadline is amended to Friday May 29, 2015

Increasing surgical and colonoscopy capacity and ensuring timely access are priorities for Island Health. Expansion of surgical and colonoscopy services at some Island Health facilities is constrained due to lack of additional capacity. Island Health is inviting qualified Proponents to submit proposals to provide surgical day-care and colonoscopy procedures and associated services as outlined in this Request for Proposal ("RFP"). Proponents may choose to submit a proposal for the surgical day-care or the colonoscopy component or both. The overarching goal of this initiative is to shift appropriate daycare cases to the provider's facility, allowing hospital facilities to increase capacity for higher acuity patients requiring inpatient care.

The successful Proponent(s) will provide and operate a non-hospital based surgical centre (Service Facility) capable of providing high quality day care surgical and colonoscopy procedures and related services that function in a seamless and integrated manner with existing Island Health hospital facilities. The Service Facility will be for daycare surgical and/or colonoscopy procedures in Greater Victoria and colonoscopy procedures in Central Island (Nanaimo or surrounding area) and will be at locations that focus on ease of access in terms of physical plant design, for both patients and providers and offers proximity and integration with current Island Health surgical services at Royal Jubilee Hospital, Victoria General Hospital, and Nanaimo General Hospital.

Island Health surgeons and anesthesiologists will attend at the Service Facility and complete procedures with the same high quality as is currently completed at the existing hospital facilities. Surgeons and anesthesiologists will be scheduled using the Island Health operating room allocation and colonoscopy booking models. Patients receiving care at the Service Facility will be booked by Island Health from its waitlist. Quality assurance and improvement processes will be fully integrated with Island Health through the Surgery Program.
